

In this letter with practical information we will tell you more about your flat. So that you know what to bring and what not. And what you do and don't have to think about anymore.

NUMBER OF PERSONS

We have three different flats at our disposal. They all differ in size, layout and possibilities.

When booking, you have already chosen one of these three types, and the number of people you are coming with.

If you come with more people than the number of beds, there is the possibility to add an extra bed or cot. We have probably already contacted you about this.

If you come with fewer people, a number of beds will remain unused. You can choose which are these beds.

COSTS

At the time of booking you have seen a total amount.

In the amount are always included: the rent of the flat including energy, TV and internet, and a final cleaning. This price differs per flat.

In addition, the following costs are added: tourist tax (€2 per person per night), bed linen (€6,50 per person at a time) and €50 (deposit).

In addition to the above you can add extras:

- Making the bed. We can do this for you prior to your arrival. The costs are €3,50 extra per person.
- Bath towels: €4,50 per set of towels (per person). Of course you can also bring your own from home.
- Kitchen linen: dry towels, wipes, sponges, washing-up liquid, brush. €5 per set (one set is sufficient for a short stay).
- Breakfast: €10 per adult per day and €5 per child. See the general information letter for more info.

You can already add the above options when booking, but of course you can also indicate at a later date if you would like to make use of them.

DEPOSIT

We charge a deposit of €50,-, which you pay at check-in. We ask you to return the flat swiipe clean, report any breakages to us, and not to smoke inside or make any changes to the flat. Further on in this instruction you will read what we expect from you regarding the delivery of your flat.

If you leave the flat in the desired manner, you will receive this deposit back. At check-in you will be given a document with which you can fill in the desired bank details.

INVENTORY

What things are there, and what should I bring myself?

We answer these questions here, which applies to all flats. For each flat we also provide an inventory list, which you will receive with the information folder at check-in. After each stay we check this list for loss or breakage, because we want to make sure the flat is complete again for your next visit.

Do you notice anything during your stay, does something break or are there any other remarks? If so, we would appreciate it if you pass this on to us, you can also write it down in your folder. We will then discuss with you how we can solve this.

Each flat has its own facilities:

- Bedrooms, of which at least 1 room with bedside table, reading light and own TV
- The beds are provided with 1 pillow and 1 duvet. The compulsory bed linen package consists of 1 pillowcase, 1 duvet cover and 1 sheet per person.
- All double beds can be pushed apart. Would you like to indicate this in advance?
- One or more wardrobes

- Kitchenette with combi-oven, dishwasher and induction hob
- Kettle
- Filter coffee maker
- Knife set with scissors
- Crockery, cutlery and glassware
- Pan set (1 frying pan, 1 saucepan and 3 pots)
- Colander, bottle opener and peeler
- Waste bin
- Hand sweeper and can

- Sitting area with bench(s) and chair(s)
- Television
- Decoration and lighting

- Dining area with plenty of chairs
- Magazines and magazines
- One or a few board games

- Bathroom with walk-in shower
- Hand soap at the washbasin
- Hair & body wash
- Mirror with lighting
- Toilet with toilet brush
- Waste bin

Please note: all consumables and appliances that are not listed are not present.

Think of toilet paper, hairdryer, washing machine or dryer, coffee filters, dishwasher tablets, spices, food, wipes...

For your convenience, we offer starter kits, which you can take with you at check-in.

A starter kit costs €6.50 at a time and is made up of the following items

- 2 coffee filters
- 100 grams filter coffee
- 2 toilet rolls
- 2 bin liners for the kitchen
- 1 waste bag for the bathroom
- 2 dishwasher tablets

(FINAL) CLEANING

All apartments are cleaned after your departure and/or prior to your visit.

However, the intention is that you 'wipe clean', discuss any break with us and do not smoke. What does all this mean?

- Do not smoke in the apartment and do not make any permanent changes.
- Was anything broken or damaged during your stay? Make a note of this on the information sheet and discuss it during check-out.- At the end of your stay, remove the bedding. You can put the sheets and covers in the pillowcase. Put everything by the bathroom door.
- If you have hired towels, put them with you, you can put them all by the bathroom door.
- Clean the kitchen worktop and empty the dishwasher.
- Empty the fridge and other cupboards, and take the rubbish bags out of the bins. You can put the rubbish in your flat by the outside door.
- Don't leave things lying around on the floor, if you have tampered with it, clean it or wipe it up.
- Return furniture to its original place.

After this you can check out. Return the key together with the information folder (possibly with your comments) to reception.
